Mouth Care Is Body Care

Your body is designed to protect itself. Eyes water to remove harmful particles, perspiration prevents overheating, and when you develop an infection, your immune system reacts immediately ... and the result is inflammation.

When plaque is allowed to build up on teeth, it hardens into tartar. If not removed professionally and regularly, it will lead to swollen bleeding gums – which means an active bacterial infection or gum disease.

WHICH IS BEST?

Sportsguard or nightguard

Can a sportsguard double-up as a nightguard and vice versa? Mouthguards – for sleep or play – are designed specifically for each application, so the answer is no.

Here's why...

- Sportsguard The odds of a mouth injury is 30-50% over your athletic career. Sportsguards absorb external impact and protect your cheeks, lips, and tongue from bites and cuts ... and decrease the risk of concussion. They work best when custom-made for a perfect fit and to give the highest level of protection.
- Nightguard Tooth grinding or clenching while sleeping can cause tooth fractures and chips, sore jaws, and even broken restorations. Nightguards intercept upper-to-lower tooth contact while putting your jaw in optimum position.

It's An Emergency!

Do you know what to do?

Toothache: Rinse with warm salt water and apply a cold compress. A toothache will never go away on its own — it needs treatment. Swelling, radiating heat, and fever can be a sign of infection. Call us and we'll get you in right away.

Lost/Broken Permanent Tooth: This common injury is distressing, but try to stay calm. If you find the tooth, handle it by the crown (not the root), put it in milk, and call us immediately.



Cut tongue, lip, or cheek: With a cool wet cloth, apply pressure to stop the bleeding. If it persists, call us immediately.

Crown and bridge treatment for your smile

A **crown** is a dental restoration that restores a tooth to its natural shape and size.

A **bridge** is a restoration that attaches a replacement tooth to a crown to fill a gap left by a missing tooth.

Could you be a candidate for a crown? Or a bridge?

 Crown and bridge treatment is very important because spaces left by missing teeth can allow adjacent teeth to drift, which changes your bite and can cause severe wear, discomfort or pain, tooth sensitivity, headaches, jaw problems, and even encourage cavities.

When teeth are broken, cracked, or structurally weakened by large fillings or root canal treatment, they can be supported and even saved by a crown.

Take preventive measures to avoid complex more-expensive treatments later. By repairing compromised teeth with natural-looking crowns and bridges, you can have that healthy beautiful smile you've always dreamed about!


Ingredients

- 3 cups cooked quinoa
- 1 cup frozen peas, thawed

Dressing

- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 3 tbsp apple cider vinegar
- 1/3 cup feta cheese
- 1/3 cup fresh mint, chopped
- black pepper to taste
- sweeten with sugar substitute

Cook quinoa according to package directions. In a large bowl, add cooled quinoa, peas, and feta. In a small bowl, whisk dressing ingredients then pour over the salad. Add chopped mint, toss, and serve.
